

# Cyprus Super Senior Amateur Men's & Ladies Opens 2025

Minthis GC, Paphos, Cyprus 20 – 21 September 2025

# **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

#### 1. ELIGIBILITY

Amateur gentlemen and lady players who on 20 September 2025 have reached the age of 65 years old, conform to the current Amateur Status Rules of the R&A, and hold a current and valid WHS HI within the limits specified in paragraph 4, are eligible for entry in either the Cyprus Senior Amateur Men's & Ladies Opens OR the Cyprus Super Senior Amateur Men's & Ladies Opens are NOT WAGR eligible events. At Registration, on Friday, 19 September, entrants (other than CGF Federated players) must provide proof of current handicap certified on or after 14 September 2025.

# 2. BUGGIES, CADDIES AND TROLLEYS

Cyprus Super Senior Amateur Men's & Ladies Opens entrants are free to choose to walk or ride in a buggy by submitting the appropriate Entry Application Form (additional fees apply with the buggy option). *Buggies are limited and will be on a first-come-first-served basis.* Players in buggies are not allowed caddies. Walking competitors are permitted electric or manual trolleys and caddies are allowed.

# 3. ENTRY APPLICATION AND FEES

- Applications for Entry must be made through the appropriate online Entry Application Form found on the CGF's website
  (<a href="https://www.cgf.org.cy/events/CSSAMLO25">https://www.cgf.org.cy/events/CSSAMLO25</a>) no later than Monday, 15 September 2025. Should the events be
  oversubscribed a Waitlist will be created with preference given to international players and those with low handicaps.
- Entry fee for those Super Seniors walking is €145 (€95 for CGF Members and €40 for Minthis GC Members).
- Entry fee for those Super Seniors riding a buggy is €185 (€135 for CGF Members and €80 for Minthis GC Members).
- International players receive a complimentary practice round 9without a buggy), while all competitors receive two competition rounds, fruit, water, free range balls on Days 1 & 2, and a prize presentation buffet on Day 2.

# 4. FORM OF PLAY & HANDICAP LIMIT

Both tournaments are 36-hole stroke play events, handicap qualifying, using the Yellow tees for men and the Red tees for ladies. The tournaments will be played in accordance with the rules of golf as approved by the R&A, the Cyprus Golf Federation, and any Local Rules endorsed by the Tournament Committee. In the event of a tie for the Super Seniors tournament, places will be determined on count back. The maximum exact WHS HI for entry for men is 24.0 and for ladies 30.0.

During play for both days, Live Scoring will be in operation, with scorers posted at predetermined places. Participants are required to cooperate with and assist the scorers in performing their duties.

# 5. TROPHIES

The winners of the tournaments will be the "Men's CGF Super Seniors Champion" and the "Ladies CGF Super Seniors Champion" of the year. Net trophies will be available, while on Day 2 a Hole-in-One prize will be available on a par 3 hole (multiple winners share).

# 6. REGISTRATION

Official Registration is at Minthis GC on Friday, 19 September, between 0800 and 1330. Any player unable to register by 1330 must call +357 96 533813 to confirm his participation.

# 7. PRACTICE

International Players wishing to book their free practice round on Thursday, 18 September or Friday, 19 September, should make direct contact with the club (email:  $golf@minthisresort.com \mid phone: +357\ 26\ 842200$ ). Additional practice rounds can be booked at a preferential rate of  $\mathfrak{C}50$ .

# 8. MEDICAL CARE

During play, a doctor will be on call at player's own expense.
